DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIONS

THIS DECLARATION, made this "the day of September 1968, by Corona Land Co., a California corporation, herein reserved to as "Declaram".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS. Deciarant is the owner of all of the real property set forth and described on that certain map (herein called "Map") entitled Tract No. 3804. consisting of 11 sheets. marked respectively, "Sheet I of II sheets". which Map was recorded in II sheets" through "Sheet II of II sheets". which Map was recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California. on October 1 1968, in Book 60 of Subdivision, Page 175 11 No.

WHEREAS, all of the real property described in the Map comprises in the aggregate a single subdivision unit (herein called 'Unit') which is one of several units in the Canyon take general subdivision (herein called "Subdivision") which have been or shall be developed from adjoining lands owned by Occiarant and annexed to the Subdivision as detailed herein and in the initial filing with the California Real Estate Commissioner relating to the Subdivision (Trac: No. 1894); and

WHEREAS, there are two hundred and sixty-one (281) subdivided lots set forth and described in the recorded Map, numbered 1 through 281, respectively, and lettered lots A. B. and C: and

WHEREAS. Deciarant is about to sell and convey said lots, other than those numbered lots 128 and 127 and lettered lots A. B. and C therein called "exempt lots") and before doing so desires to subject them to and impose upon them mutual and beneficial restrictions. them to and impose upon them mutual and beneficial restrictions. covenants, conditions and charges, hereinafter collectively referred to as "Restrictions", under a general plan or scheme of improvement for as "Restrictions", under a general plan or scheme of improvement for the benefit and complement of all of the lots in the Unit and Subdivision, and the future owners of said lots, other than the exempt lots:

NOW. THEREFORE. Deciarant hereby deciares that all of said lots, other than the exempt lots, are held and shall be held, conveyed, hypothecated or encumpered, leased, rented, used, occupied, and improved subject to the following Restrictions, all of which are declared and agreed to be in furtherance of a plan for the subdivision, improved ment, and sale of said lots and are established and agreed upon for the purpose of enhancing and protecting the value, destrability and attractiveness of the property described in the Map and of the Subdivision as a whole. All of the Restrictions shall run with the land and shall be binding on all parties having or sequiring any right, title or interest in the real property or any part thereof subject to such Restrictions.

1. APPLICABILITY

These Restrictions shall apply to subdivided, numbered lots only, other than the exempt lots, and are specifically excluded from application to said exempt lots and to other lands designated on the Map as parcel or as lands of Declarant, which exempt lots, parcels and lands are intended for future commercial, multiple dwelling, single family residence, or recreational uses.

These Restrictions thall affect and run with the land and shall exist and be binding upon all parties and all perrons claiming under them until January 1, 2003, their which time the same shall be extended for successive periods of ten (10) years each, unless an instrument signed by a majority of the then owners of the lots subject thereto has been recorded, agreeing to change the covenants in whole or in part. These Restrictions may be amended at any time by written consent of two-thirds (2/3) of the record owners of such lots.

3. MUTUALITY OF BENEFIT AND OBLICATION

The Restrictions and agreements set forth herein are made for the mutual and reciprocal benefit of each and every lot in the Unit and the Subdivision to which they are applicable, as herein provided, and are intended to create mutual, equitable servitudes upon each of said lots in favor of each and all of the other lots therein; to create reciprocal rights between the respective owners of all of said lots; to diprocal rights between the respective owners of all of said lots; to diprocal rights between the respective owners of all of said lots; to diprocal rights between the respective owners of said lots; their heirs, successors and assigns; and shall, as to the owner lots, their heirs, successors and assigns; and shall, as to the owner of each such lot, his heirs, successors or assigns, operate as coverants running with the land for the benefit of cach and all other lots in the Unit and Subdivision and their respective owners. Restrictions substantially the same as those contained herein shall be recorded on all future recorded tracts of the Subdivision in conformity with the general scheme of improvement of all lands to be included therein.

4. EXCLUSIVE RESIDENTIAL USE AND IMPROVEMENT

No lot shall be used except for residential purposes. No structures shall be erected, placed or permitted to remain on any lot other than one (1) detached, single family residence dwelling and such outbuildings as are usually accessory to a single family residence dwelling including a private garage and, in the case of a lot contiguous to a lake or shore-line, a boat shelter, pier, or other similar structure approved as herein provided.

5: CANYON LAKE PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION

Every person, including Declarant, who acquires title, legal or equitable, to any lot in the Subdivision shall become a member of the Canyon Lake Property Owners Association, a California non-profit corporation, (herein referred to as "Association"); provided however, corporation, (herein referred to as "Association"); provided however, that such membership is not intended to apply to those persons who that such membership is not intended to apply to those persons who that such membership is not intended to apply to those persons who that such membership for the performance hold an interest in any such lot merciy as security for the performance of an obligation to pay money, e.g., mortgages, deeds of trust, or real estate contract purchases. Declarant's membership (by reason of its ownership of unsold lots) need not be evidenced by certificates of membership as provided in the Association's by-laws.

The general purpose of the Association is to further and promote the community welfare of property owners in the Subdivision. So as to assure the opportunity to all owners to acquire full knowledge of said Association's activities, each such owner shall be notified not less than Association's activities, each such owner shall be notified not less than seven (7) days nor more than sixty (60) days prior to any meeting of Association members. Said notice shall specify a reasonable place, date and hour, and in the case of a special meeting, the general nature of the business to be constructed.

The Association shall be responsible for the maintenance, repair, and upkeep of the private streets and parks, pedestrian easements, within the Subdivision, and the appurtenant drainage improvements and slope the Subdivision, and the appurtenant drainage improvements and slope casements reserved by Declarant. Spid maintenance, repair and upkeep shall be done in a continual and workmentike manner and in no case shall shall be done in a continual and workmentike manner and in no case shall the level of such maintenance, repair and upkeep be below the level of the level of such maintenance, repair and upkeep be below the level of such care which would have been provided by the County of Riverside, had such streets, parks, pedestrial casements, drainage casements and slope casements been owned by said County.

The Association shall also be the means for the promutgation and enforcement of all regulations necessary to the governing of the use and enjoyment of such streets and parks and such other properties within the Subdivision as it may from time to time own.

The Association shall also be responsible for the maintenance and operation of the recreational facilities to be acquired by the Association from the Declarant. by means of a Trust Agreement, when 3500 single family residential lots have been sold by Declarant in said Subdivision, or on January 31, 1973, whichever occurs first. At such time, the Association shall also be the means for the promulgation and enforcement of all regulations necessary to the governing of the use and enjoyment of such recreations facilities.

For the purpose of proportionately dividing the Association's expenses immered in the maintenance of its properties and in furthering and promoting his purposes, the Association shall have all the powers that are set forth in its purposes, the Association and By-Laws or that belong to it by operation and law, including the power to levy against every lot in the Subdivision uniform annual charges as set foth in its by-laws of not less than Twenty form annual charges as set foth in its by-laws of not less than Twenty Dollars (\$20,00) nor more than Fifty Dollars \$50,00) per year for the operation and maintenance of the streets, parks, perestrian easements, drainage improvements and slope easements; and not less than One flundred drainage improvements and slope easements; and not less than One flundred Eight Dollars (\$108,00) nor more than Two Hungred Dollars (\$200,00) for Eight Dollars (\$108,00) nor more than Two Hungred Dollars (\$200,00) for

Every such charge made shall be paid by the member to the Association on or before the date established by its Board of Directors pursuant to the resolution adopted by such Board fixing the amount of the annual charge. Written notice of the charge so fixed and the date of payment charge. Written notice of the charge so fixed and the date of payment shall be sent to each member. Said charges shall remain a lien upon the property of the respective member until paid.

Upon the adoption of a resolution of charges, the Association shall ferthwith cause a notice therof and of the lies created thereby to be signed and acknowledged by it and recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.

Such recorded notice shall embody said resolution and state the rate of the charge, the time payable, and when it becomes a lien. When paid, the Association shall from time to time execute, acknowledge and record in the Office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California, a release or releases of lies with respect to the property for which payment has been made. Full receipts shall be issued to lot owners upon payment.

Each lot owner in the Subdivision shall, by acceptance of a deed therete or the signing of a contract or agreement to purchase the same, whether from Declarant or a subsequent owner of such lot, bind himself, his heirs, personal representatives and assigns to pay all charges determined and levied upon such lot, including interest thereon and collection costs thereof, if any, including attorneys' fees; and the obligation to pay such charges, interest and costs thereof constitutes an obligation running with the land, safe or transfer of any lot shall not affect any lies for charges provided for herein.

All liens herein provided for shall be enforceable by foreclosure and sale proceedings in the manner provided by law for the foreclosure and sale of mortgages and/or trust deeds: provided, however, that no proceeding for foreclosure shall be commenced except upon expiration of two (2) months from and after the date the charge giving rise to such lien becomes due and payable.

The funds arising from such charges, so far as may be sufficient, shall be applied toward the payment of expenses incurred by the Association in the maintenance of its properties and in furthering and promoting the community weifare of property owners in the Subdivision, all as set forth and provided in its articles of incorporation and by-

. ARCHITECTUAL CONTROL COMMITTEE

All plans and specifications for any structure or improvement whatsoever to be creeted on or moved upon or to any lot, and the proposed location thereof on any lot or lots, the construction material, the roofs and exterior color schemes, any later changes or additions after initial approval fluoreof, and any remodeling, reconstruction, alterations, or additions thereto on any lot shall be subject to and shall require the approval in writing before any such work is commenced of the Architectual Control Committee (herein called "Committee"), as the same is from time to time composed.

The Committee shall be composed of three (3) members to be appointed by Declarant. Committee members shall be subject to removal by Declarant and any vacancies from time to time existing shall be filled by appointment of Deciarant, or in the event of Declarant's failure to so appoint within two (2) months after any sen vacancy, then by the Board of Directors of the Association. When ninety percent (90%) of the lots in the Subdivision shall have been sold by Declarant, the Board of Directors of the Association shall have complete control of the appointments and removal of Committee members. Either a lapse of eighteen (18) months between filings of unit maps of the Subdivision, provided that ninety percent (90%) of the then aggregate number of lots in all recorded units of the Subdivision have been sold by Declarant, or a lapse of three (3) years from the date of the Final Subdivision Public Report of the California Division of Real Estate applicable to the next preceding unit of the Subdivision, regardless of whether or not ninety percent (90%) of the aggregate number of lots in all recorded units of the Subdivision have been sold, shall be sufficient to place control for such appointments and removals in the Association's Board of Directors.

There shall be submitted to the Committee two (2) complete sets of plans and specifications for any and all proposed improvements, the erection or alteration of which is desired, and no structures or improvements of any kind shall be erected, altered, placed or maintained upon any lot unless and until the final plans, elevations, and specifications therefor have received such written approval as herein provided. Such plans shall include plot plans showing the location on the lot of the building, wall, fence, or other structure proposed to be constructed, altered, placed or maintained, together with the proposed construction material, color schemes for roofs and exteriors thereof and proposed landscape planting. In addition, topography maps prepared by a registered civil engineer or a licensed land surveyor shall be included as part of all plans relating to lakefront lots.

As a means of defraying its expenses, the Committee may institute and require a repsonaute filing (se to accompany the sub-institute and require a repsonaute filing (se to accompany the sub-institute and required for resubmission of plans to it. No additional (se snall be required for resubmission of plans revised in accordance with Committee recommendations.

The Committee small approve or disapprove plans, specification and details within thirty (30) days from the receipt thereof or shall notify the person submitting them that an additional period of time, not exceed thirty (30) days, is required for such approval or disapproved proval. Plans, specifications and details not approved or disapproved within the time limits provided herein shall be deemed approved as within the time limits provided herein shall be deemed approved as submitted. One (1) set of said plans and specifications and details with the approval or disapproval, endorsed thereon, shall be returned to the person submitting them and the other copy thereof shall be retained by the Committee for its permanent files.

The Committee shall have the right to disapprove any plans, specifications or details submitted to it in the event the same are not in accordance with all of the provisions of this Declaration; if the design or color scheme of the proposed building or other structure the design or color scheme of the proposed building or other structures the adjacent buildings or structures; if the plans and specifications the adjacent buildings or structures; if the plans and specifications submitted are incomplete; or in the event the Committee deems the submitted are incomplete; or in the event the committee deems the plans, specifications or details, or any part thereof, to be contrary plans, specifications or details, or any part of the real to the interests, welfare or rights of all or any part of the real property subject hereto, or the owners thereof. The decisions of the Committee shall be final.

Neither the Committee nor any architect or agent thereof or of Deciarant shall be responsible in any way for any defects in any plans or specifications submitted, revised or approved in accordance with the foregoing provisions, nor for any structural or other defects in any work done according to such plans and specifications.

Whenever the Committee shall approve plans and specifications for a boat shelter, pier. float or similar structure, on or extending into any lake, such approval shall not constitute a permit to build or place such proposed structure without the consent of the owner or operator of the lake.

1. SIZE AND PLACEMENT OF RESIDENCES AND STRUCTURES

Every residence dwelling constructed on a lot shall contain the following minimum square feet of fully enclosed floor area devoted to living purposes (exclusive of roofed or unroofed porches, terraces, garages, carports and other outbuildings):

Waterfront lots
All other lots
1,000 sq. ft.

Each such dwelling shall be of single story construction: provided, however, that split level or two story residences may be constructed on lots where, in the opinion of the Committee, the terrain of such lot lends itself to such construction.

The Committee small have the authority to set up regulations as to the height and size requirements for all other types of buildings and structures, including fences, walls, copings, etc.

In order to preserve the natural quality and esthetic appearance of the existing geographic areas within the Subdivision, all property lines abutting to any lake or golf course shall be kept free and open and no fences shall be permitted on any such lot lines except where, in the opinion of the Committee, a fence or other enclosure, as a structure or esthetic feature of a design concept, will contribute to and be in keeping with the character of the area.

Whenever two or more contiguous lots in the Subdivision shall be owned by the same person, and such person shall desire to use two or more of said lots as a site for a single dwelling house, he shall apply in writing to the Architectual Comrol Committee for permission so to use said lots. If written permission of such a use shall be gramed, the lots constituting the site for sech single dwelling house shall be treased as a single lot for the purpose of applying these Restrictions to said lots, so long as the lots remain improved with a single dwelling house.

Each lot has a specified and dimensioned area which limits the extent of the portion thereof upon which any improvement can be constructed without the express approval of the Committee. In this event, the following minimum dimensions shall govern for floor elevations on lakefront lots and for front, side and rear setbacks on all lots (except fences or walls where approved or required by the Committee):

- (a) First floor elevation of 1397.5 feet M.S.L. on all lakefront
- (h) Twemy (20) feet from the front line of each lot abutting the street;
- (c) Five (5) feet from each lot side line, except corner lots which shall be ten (10) feet;
- (d) Twemy (20) feet, or twenty-five (25%) percent of the depth of the lot, whichever is greater, from the rear line of each lot, unless such rear lot line small be either contiguous to a boundary line of the golf course in which case the depth of the rear yard shall be twenty-five (25) feet or twenty-five (25%) percent of the depth of the lot, whichever is greater; or contiguous to a lake shoreline, in which even the depth of the rear yard shall be thirty (30) feet-or twenty-five percent (25%) of the depth of the lot, whichever is greater, however, that on any lot, the rear line of which is contiguous to a lake shoreline, there may be constructed is contiguous to a lake shoreline, there may be constructed and maintained, at or adjacent to such shoreline, any best shelter, pier, or similar structure in respect to the size, design, construction or placement of which the Committee shall have issued a permit or license.
- (e) If the line with respect to which a sethack measurement is to be made is a meandering line, the average length of the two lot lines that intersect said meandering line

shall be determined and, using that average length, as imaginary straight like anall be arown through the measurement line and the setback measurement shall be made along a line perpendicular to such imaginary line.

- (f) The term "side line" defines a lot boundary line that extends from the street on which the lot abute to the rear line of the lot.
- (g) The term "rear lot line" defines the bossniary line of the lot that is farthest from, and substantially parallel to, the line of the sireet on which the lot shorts.
- (h) The term "front-line" defines a lot boundary line that is abutting the right of way of the street on which the lot abuts.
- (i) A corner lot shall be deemed to have a from line on the street on which the sanctest dimension abutting a street occurs.
- (j) No part of any scace or wall shall be constructed or placed within the "front yard" of any numbered let in the Subdivision, that is to say, within that part of the lot that lies between the line of the street on which the lot about and the required scheck from the front line of the lot. No sence or wall shall be constructed or placed within that part of any lot that is contiguous to either a lake or the golf course that lies within twenty-five (25) feet of the rear lot line, and no part of any sence or wall constructed or placed in the rear yard of any lot that is contiguous to a lake or the golf course shall exceed three (3) feet in height. Any sence that is permitted within the Subdivision and is not subject to the height limitation set out in the immediately preceding sentence may have a height not in excess of five (5) feet.

& GEOGRAL PROHIBETIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

The following general prohibitions and requirements shall prevail as to the construction or activities conducted on any lot in the Unit or Subdivision:

- (a) No outside inflet or individual water well shall be constructed on any lot. All physician fixtures, dishwanters, inflets or sewage disposal systems shall be connected to the community sawage system.
- (h) He temporary structure or other outhelding shall be placed or erected on any lot; provided, however, that the Committee may grant permission for any

such temporary structure for storage of materials during construction. No such temporary structures as may be approved shall be used at any time as a dwelling place.

- (c) No monile home, house or travel trailer, camper wit, test or other temporary living quarters shall be placed, maintained or occupied on any lot empet that the owner thereof upon completion and example of the principal dwelling may store such items on his property in a reasonable manner, except as otherwise prohibited herein.
- (d) No residence shall be occupied until the same has been seintantially completed in accordance with its plans and specifications and a certificate permitting occupancy shall have been issued by the Riverside County Building Department.
- (a) All structures constructed or placed on any lot shall be constructed with a substantial quantity of new material and no used structures shall be relocated on any such lot.
- (f) No animals or livestock of any description, except the usual housefold pets, shall be kept on any lot.
- (g) Signs of customary and renounable dimensions, but not exceeding five (5) square feet, shall be permitted to be displayed on any lot advertising the same for sale. All other signs, billhourds, or advertising structures of any kind are prohibited except upon application to and written permission from the Committee,
- (a) No stripped down, partially wrecked, or jank motor vehicle or sizeable part thereof, shall be permitted to be parked on any street in the Unit or Subdivision or en any tot in such manner as to be visible to the occupants of other lots within the Unit or Subdivision or to the users of any street, lake or golf course therein. He track larger than 3/4 Ton small be parked, for evernight (or longer) storage, on any numbered lot in the Unit or Subdivision in such a manner as to be visible to the occupants of other lots in the Unit or Subdivision or the users of any street. Jake or golf course within the Unit or Subdivision.
- (1) Every tank for the storage of feel installed outside any building in the Unit or Subdivision shall be havied below the surface of the ground or otherwise completely surcened, to the satisfaction of the Committee. Every outdoor receptable for ashes, trash, rubbish or garbage shall be installed

underground, screened or so placed and kept as not to be visible from any street, lake or golf remove within the Unit or Suldivision at any time except during refuse collections.

- (i) He owner of any lot shall build or permit the building thereon of any dwelling house that is to be used as a small house or exhibit unless prior written permission to do so shall have been obtained from the Committee.
- All lots, whether excepted or unsecrepted, and any improvements placed thereon, shall at all liters be unsimised in such a security as to provent their becausing unnightly by running of mattractive. growth on, such lot or the accumulation of reinish or deleris thereon. In the event any such lot or improvement thereon is not so unnintered, the Association shall have the right, through the agents and employees, to enter thereon for the purpose of maintenance, restoration or repair, the oast of which shall be added to and because a part of the named charge to which such lot is subject.

 - (m) He oil or materal gas drilling, reflected, quarrying, or mining operations of any kind simil be permitted upon or in any lot and no descrick or other structure designed for use in boring for oil or natural gas deall be erected, maintained or permitted on any lot.
 - (a) No tree in excess of three (3) inches in diameter, measured at a point tweive inches (12") shove the grammi, shall be reserved from any lot without first obtaining the written consent of the Committee.
 - (a) No rusio station or shortwave operators of any blad shall operate from any lot or residence. No exterior television or rusio automa, of any ideal shall be constructed or excetted on any lot or rusio dence after such time as a community subsense. television (CATY) system has been smale swellable to residences at rates of charge for installation and bundley service communication with the rules obarged by comparable CATY systems.
 - (a) No trash, ashes, garbage or other refine shall be damped or stored on any let now be thrown into or left on the shareline of any labe in the Schilivisian. He outside burning of trash or garbage shall be permitted.
- (a) No improvement which has been partially or totally destroyed by fire, earthquake or otherwise, shall

be allowed to remain in such state for more than three (3) mondis from the time of such destruction.

- (r) Every building, deciling, or other improvement, the construction or placement of which is begun en any lot, shall be completed within six (6) macula after the beginning of such construction or placement.
- (a) In order to enhance the appearance and orderliness of . the Subdivision. the Deciarant hereby reserves for itself. Its successors and assigns, the exclusive right to operate, a commercial scavenging service within the Subdivision for the purpose of removing parbage, trash, and other like household refuse. Such refuse collection and removal service shall be provided not less often than once each week on a day or days designated by the Declarant or its successors and assigns. The charge to be made for such refuse collection and removal service shall be at a reasonable rate commensurate with the rates charged by commercial scaveagers serving other subdivisions of high standards in the area and shall be subject to change from time to time. Initially, the charge for such service shall be Two Dollars (\$2,00) per month.
 - (t) Every building, dwelling or other improvement having a reof shall use a roof covering material of ceuar shakes, wood shingles, clay or cement tile or built-up roofing and colored rock

9. VARIANCES

The Committee may allow reasonable variances and adjustments of these Restrictions in order to overcome practical difficulties and prevent unnecessary hardships in the application of the provisions contained herein; provided, however, that such is done in conformity with the intent and purposes hereof and provided also that in every instance such variance or adjustment will not be materially defrimental or injurious to other property or improvements in the neighborhood, the Unit or Subdivision.

10. EASEMENTS

Declarant reserves for itself, its successors and assigns, for pures incident to its development of the real property subject to these Restrictions, the following easements and/or rights-of-way:

- (a) For the use and maintenance of drainage courses of all kinds designated on the Map as "Drainage Easements".
- (h) For maintenance and permanent stabilization control f slopes in the slope-control areas designated on the Map as "Slope Essements".
- (e) For lake and shoreline maintenance and control along he lakefront portion of each lot contiguous to a lake shoreline to the extent of ten (10) feet in width designated on the Map as "Utility Maintenance Pasements"; and

(d) For the installation and maintenance of radio and television transmission cables over alrips of land siz (6) vision transmission cables over alrips of land siz (6) feet in width along the front property line of ten (10) feet in width along the front property line of each lot.

Declarant has dedicated to the public non-exclusive rights-of-way and easement areas for the installation and maintenance of public utilities over strips of land six (6) feet in width slong side and rear property lines of each lot as contained in the offer of dedication set forth on lines of each lot as contained in the offer of dedication set forth on the strip of the Map, reserving therefrom the easements and/or rights-of-way set forth in subparagraph (d), above, relating to radio and television transmission caules.

On each lot, the right-of-way and casement areas reserved by Declarant or dedicated to public utilities purposes shall be maintained continuously by the lot owner but no structures, plantings or other activities material shall be placed or permitted to remain or other activities undertaken which may damage or interfere with the installation or mainumetraken which may damage or interfere with the installation or mainumetraken which may damage the direction of flow of drainage theannels in the casements; which may obstruct or retard the flow of water through drainage channels in the casements; or which damage or water through drainage channels in the casements; or which damage or water through drainage channels in the casements; or which damage or interfere with established slope ratios or create crossion or sliding interfere with established slope ratios or create crossion or sliding problems. Improvements within such areas shall also be maintained by the respective lot owner except for those for which Declarant, its successors and assigns, a public authority, or utility company is responsible.

On the recorded plat of the Subdivision there is depicted the location of a line of sanitary sewers. Every numbered lot in the Subdivision that is crossed by said line of sanitary sewers shall be subject to an exament for the installation, operation, maintenance, repair, replacement, relocation, or removal of said line of sanitary renewal, replacement, relocation, or removal of land that is ten (10) feet sewers, which easement shall be a strip of land that is ten (10) feet in width, measured five (5) feet on each side of the center line.

Every numbered lot in the Subdivision that lies contiguous to a lake shall be subject to a flowage easement to an elevation on the lot equal to the high water elevation of such lake as stated on the recorded plat.

11. OWNERSHIP, USE AND ENJOYMENT OF STREETS, PARKS AND RECREATIONAL AMENITIES

Each of the streets in the Unit or Subdivision designated on the Map, except Railroad Canyon Road, is a private street, and every park, recreational facility, and other amenity within the Unit or Subdivision is a private park, facility or amenity. An easement for the use and emjoyment of each of said streets and areas designated on the Map as emjoyment of each of said streets and areas designated on the Map as petestrian easements, and areas designated on the recorded Map as pedestrian easements, is reserved to Declarant, its successors and assigns; to the members or associate members persons who are, from time to time, members or associate members of the Association; to the residents, tenants, and occupants of any multi-family

residential building, gresthouse, him or notel facilities, and all other kinds of residential structures that may be creeted within the boundaries of the Unit-or Subdivision, to the owner and/or operator of the dam and lake facility, its successors and assigns, and to the invitees of all of the sigrementioned persons.

Declarant has previously offered said private streets to Riverside County for dedication to public use. the acceptance of which was rejected.

The Property Owner's Association may request the inclusion of said streets into the County Street System, at any time, provided, however, that such request shall not be made by said Association except upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote of its members entitled to vote.

Deciarant hereby covenants. for itself, its successors, and assigns, that it will convey (ce simple title to the streets and to those areas designated as parks and those areas designated on the recorded Map as pedestrish essements, and on all future maps of the Subdivision, to the Association within three (3) years after their completion, subject only to ensements of record and utility rights. At the time of conveyance, such streets shall conform to the standards of Riverside County.

Speed limits and parking regulations and restrictions on such private streets and the rules governing the use of such parks shall be as promulgated from time to time by Decinrant, ils successors thereto or assigns thereof.

12. LAKE FRONTAGE LOTS

The water in and the land under any lake located within the boundaries of the Subdivision, whether now in existence or to be constructed, are or will be owned by others. The location of any such lake as well as its maximum water clevation at spillway level, is or will be shown on the recorded map of each unit of the Subdivision. The title that will be acquired by a grantce of Deciarant, and to any successors or assigns of such grantee, to any lot contiguous to any such lake shall extend only to the rear lot line.

No such grantee, nor any of such grantee's successors or assigns, shall have any right with respect to any stream that is a tributary to any such lake or with respect to any such lake, the land thereunder. the water therein, or its or their elevation, use or condition and none of said lots shall have any riparian rights or incidents appurtenant; provided, further, that title shall not pass by reliction or submergence or changing water levels.

Declarant, its successors and assigns, shall have the right at any time to dredge or otherwise remove any accretion or deposit from any let in order that the shoreline of the lake to which such lot is contiguous may be moved toward or to, but not inland beyond, the location of said shoreline as it would be established on the date hereof if the water elevation in such lake were one (1) vertical foot above the maximum water cicvation at spillway level indicated in the recorded map of the

unit in the Subdivision in which it is located and title shall pass with such dreading or other removal as by crosson.

Neither the owner, operator or lessee of the lake. Declarant nor any of its successors or assigns shall be liable for damages caused by erosion, washing or other action of the water of any lake within the boundaries of the Subdivision.

Declarant reserves to itself, it successor's and assigns, the owner, operator or lessee of the lake. the right to raise and lower the water level of any lake within the boundaries of the Subdivision: provided. however, that such right shall not be construed as permitting the elevation of the water level to a point beyond that indicated on the recorded maps of the Subdivision by increasing the height of any dam or spillway or otherwise.

13. GRANTEE'S TITLE Deciarant shall convey fee title to lots within the Subdivision by grant deed subject to:

- (a) These Restrictions:
- (b) Easements and rights-of-way of record;
- (de) The reservation to Declarant of all oil. gas. gasoline and other hydro-carbon substances and all other minerals underlying and within the boundaries of such lot below a depth of one hundred (100) feet, without right of surface entry; and
 - (d) The reservation of any and all water rights regarding said property, without right of surface entry.

Such grant deed shall convey title to the lot only, the boundarier of which shall be the side. rear and front lot lines as designated on the Map, excluding any fee interest in adjacent streets or roads in the

14. ANNEXATION OF SUBSEQUENT UNITS OR PARCELS Subdivision.

Declarant, or its successor in interest, may, from time to time. and in its sole discretion, annex into the Subdivision all or any part of the following described real property, less that portion thereof to which these Restrictions are already applicable, as set forth in paragraph 1. above, and to all other units of the Subdivision presently of record to which restrictions substantially identical to those set forth herein apply:

The Easterly 10 feet of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter, the Southerly 10 feet of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter, the Easterly 10 feet of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter, the Easterly 10 feet of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter, and the Southerly 10 feet of the Northeast quarter of the Mortheast quarter, All in Section 14, Township 5 South, Range 4 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian as shown by United States Government Survey.

PARCEL 3:

The Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 35, Township 5 South, Range 4 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian, as shown by United States Covernment Survey.

PARCEL 4:

The South half of the Southeast quarter of Section 36, Township 5 South, Range 4 West, San Bermardino Base and Meridian, as shown by United States Government Survey.

PARCEL'S:

The West 2/3 of the Northwest quarter of Section 6, Township 6 South, Range 3 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian, as shown by United States Government Survey.

PARCEL 5:

Fractional Section 1, Township 6 South, Range 4 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian, as shown by United States Government Survey.

PARCEL 7:

The North half and the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter, and the North 6.88 acres of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 2, Township 6 South, Range 4 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian, as shown by United States Government Survey:

EXCEPTING from the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section, the portion thereof described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the South line of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section, which bears South 88° 38° East, 109.07 feet from the Southwest corner thereof: THENCE South 60° 39° East, along said South line, 396 feet; THENCE North 00° 21° East, 550 feet; THENCE North 88° 39° West, 396 feet; THENCE South 00° 21° West, 550 feet to the point of beginning;

ALSO EXCEPTING from the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section, the portion thereof conveyed to Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District, by Deed recorded June 6, 1958 in Book 2282 page 46 of Official Records of Riverside County, California;

ALSO EXCEPTING therefrom the watchman's house and any outbuildings appurtenant thereto, located on the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section, Together with an easement for all purposes necessary for the proper use, enjoyment and occupance of said house, over one acre of ground surrounding said house and outbuildings; ALSO ENCEPTING from said Section 2, the portion thereof included in the dam at Railroad Canyon Reservoir and in addition thereto sufficient land for all appurtenances necessary for the proper maintenance and operation of said dam at said Reservoir.

PARCEL 3:

The Southeast quarter of Section 2, Township 6 South, Range 4 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian;

EXCEPTING Uncreirons that portion thereof described as follows:

BEGINNING on the Northwesterly line of Railroad Canyon Road, at a point whence the Southeast corner of said Section bears South 40°, 46° East, 1208 feet, and running Thence North 53° 40° West, a distance of 110 feet; THENCE North 35° 20° East, a distance of 130 feet, more or less, THENCE South 53° 40° East, a distance of 130 feet, more or less, to a point on said Northwesterly line of Railroad Canyon Road; THENCE Southwesterly along said Northwesterly line of Railroad Canyon Road, to the point of beginning.

PARCEL 9:

The East half of Government Lot 2, Excepting therefrom the West half of the South 660 feet thereof. All of Government Lot 1, the North half of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter, the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter, the East quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter, and the East half of the West half of the East half of quarter, and the East half of the West half of the East half of the Northeast quarter of Section 3, Township 6 South, Range 4 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian of Government Lot 2 in Section 3, Township 6 South, Range 4 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian.

Such annexation shall be effective upon the recordation of restrictions, either by declaration or by deed, designating the property subject thereto, as an additional unit within the Subdivision, which property shall therewoon become and constitute a part of the Subdivision and the Association upon become and exercise such powers and jurisdiction over such property shall accept and exercise such powers and jurisdiction over such property as are granted to it by such restrictions. Such restrictions shall be substantially the same as those contained herein; provided, however, that:

- (a) The use in said restrictions of the word "Unit" shall be deemed to apply to the particular unit for which such restrictions are recorded; the use of the word "Subdivision" shall be deemed to mean the aggregate of all previously recorded units designated as being a part of the Canyon Lake general subdivision scheme of development; and the use of the words "lot" or "lots" shall be deemed to mean all subdivided lots described and set forth in any unit maps of the Subdivision and each unit of any multiple-family residence building or guesthouse, irm or hotel facility within the Subdivision, including condominium developments;
- (b) Such restrictions shall not discriminate against lot owners whose property is already included in the Subdivision;

- (c) The Association's powers to make assessments and enforce tiens shall not be curtailed with respect to such newly amiexed units;
- (d) The limits of uniform annual charges upon each lot in the Unit or other units already annexed to the Sub-division shall not be increased as a result of any annexation (but the Association may provide for a higher annual charge upon lots in the newly annexed unit):
- (e) Such restrictions may impose additional limitations upon the property subject thereto but shall not have the effect of alleviating any of the provisions herein or of any restrictions pertaining to other units already assexed to the Subdivision; and
- (f) No annexation of additional property shall be permitted unless the subdivision map and restrictions applicable thereto shall be recorded within three (3) years from the date of the Final Subdivision Public Report of the California Division of Real Estate applicable to the next preceding unit of the Subdivision.

Any portion of such property described above and available for ammeration into the Subdivision may, at the option of Declarant, its successors or assigns, be so annexed as a condominium, or for use as a multiple-family residential, guesthouse, inn or hotel facility. Should property related to any of such uses not be so annexed. The Association shall, nevertheless, grant to the owners thereof the right to the use and enjoyment of the private streets and parks within the Subdivision, or any other assets of the Association, upon payment of a reasonable charge for maintenance, repair and upkeep or in return for the reciprocal use and enjoyment of common areas of such facilities, or a combination of both.

15. REMEDIES

The Association or any party to whose benefit these Restrictions may inure may proceed at law or in equity to prevent the occurrence, continuation or violation of any of the Restrictions.

The remedies hereby specified are cumulative, and this specification of them shall not be taken to preciude an aggrieved party's resort to any other remedy at law, in equity, or under any statute. No delay or failure on the part of an aggrieved party to invoke an available remedy in respect of a violation of any of these Restrictions shall be held to be a waiver by that party of (or an estoppei of that party to assert) any right available to him upon the recurrence or continuance of said violation or the occurrence of a different violation.

16. GRANTEE'S ACCEPTANCE

The grantee of any lot subject to the coverage of this Deciaration, by acceptance of a deed conveying title thereto, or the execution of a contract for the purchase thereof, whether from Deciarant or a subsequent owner of such lot, shall accept such deed or contract upon and subject to each and all of these Restrictions and the agreements herein contained, and also jurisdiction, rights and powers of Deciarant, and by

men acceptance small for himself, his heirs, personal representatives, successors, and assigns, covenant, consent and agree to and with Deciarant, and to and with the granices and subsequent owners of each of the iots within the Subdivision to keep, observe, comply with and perform said Restrictions and agreements.

Each such grantee also agrees, by such acceptance, to assume, as against Deciarant, its successors or assigns, all the risks and hazards of ownership or occupancy attendent to such lot, including but not limited to its proximity to golf course lairways or lakeshores.

17. PARTIAL INVALIDITY

In the event that any one or more of the Restrictions herein set terth shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be suil a void, all remaining Restrictions shall continue unimpaired and in sell force and effect.

18. CAPTIONS

The captions of the various paragraphs of this Declaration are for convenience only and are not a part of this Deciaration and do not in any way limit or amplify the terms or provisions thereof.
